Dear parent/carer,

Throughout this term we have had an increasing problem with students bringing scooters to school. The problems have arisen due to students using them around the school site, which becomes a health and safety issue, and students asking staff to look after them during the school day. Therefore, we have made the decision that as from January students must only bring scooters into school if they can be locked up in the school's cycle shelters, in the same way that students who cycle to school store their bikes during the day.

As it is the end of term I would also like to remind you that the full information regarding uniform rules are available on the school's website as we will be expecting all students to be properly attired for the start of the new term in January. I would like to particularly point out the following features of our uniform rules;

- Black Shoes or boots which must be of a polishable material (trainers are not permissible). Boots must be a maximum of 1 inch above the ankle and should not have folded over fur tops.
- Hooded tops or tracksuit tops are not to be worn
- Girls - Black knee length skirt (skirts must not be made of stretchy material) or black uniform trousers (not jeans or fashion trouser)

May I thank you in anticipation of your support in these matters and remind you that school starts at the normal time (8.40am) on Wednesday 4th January. Can I take this opportunity to wish you a very merry Christmas.
