




and what these mean for you ...




Each classroom has a behaviour board with five zones – Gold, Silver, Green. Amber and Red with a Blue 'reflection' bubble.




Every day, you will start on the 'Green' zone.




Above the green zone there is a 'Silver zone' labelled "I am a role model".



At the top of the board there is a 'Gold zone' labelled "I am outstanding". If you finish the day on Gold, you will have a star completed with "I am outstanding because ..." and this will be displayed on the behaviour board within the classroom. One child each week will be chosen for 'Praise Assembly".



As a reward for finishing on gold or silver, you will be given either two (gold) or one (silver) raffle tickets for the weekly draw in 'Praise assembly' in order to have the opportunity to receive a GOLD POSTCARD in the post.



Below the green zone, there is a 'Red zone'. If you are put on this zone at any point, there will be a sanction:


10 minutes working alone in the classroom

Missed playtime (or part of playtime)


If you are placed on the red zone, your name will go into the class behaviour file.

Before the 'red zone' you will be given the opportunity to reflect. There is a Blue 'thought bubble' labelled 'I am reflecting'. After this time you are moved back to the green zone or onto red depending on your behaviour.
