
#### Curriculum

Reception have started their transition to year 1 this week. They had a wonderful library session with some of the children from year 1 who shared their favourite books with them. In year 1 this week the children have continued to learn about cold climates and focussed on the Northern Lights phenomena and produced some spectacular artwork inspired by their learning. Year 2 have used what they are learning about the solar system together with their art skills to make pictures of the solar system. Some children can name all of the planets in order from the sun! Year 4 continued with their swimming lessons at the University of Birmingham. Lots of the children are now swimming without



armbands which is fantastic and they will be working towards gaining their first swimming badges in the next few week.







The children also had the opportunity this week to visit the Book Bus which was in school this week. They were able to read a selection of books and choose their favourites some of which will be purchased to be used in their classrooms.



## Fit4schools

We will be working with a school sports provider Fit4schools during the summer term. The children in years 1-4 will have their PE lessons with specialist PE coaches and have access to a wide range of different activities. At lunchtimes the new school playground will be used for sports sessions for children across the school and a greater selection of sports clubs will be on offer after the May half term.

### **School Crossing Warden**

During the recent parents forum it was brought to my attention that parents would like a School Crossing Warden on Hay Green Lane. Birmingham City Council transport department were contacted who organised a traffic survey which was carried out on 1st May. The results were as follows;

Between 8.30 and 9.00am there were:

- 215 vehicles
- 10 adults on foot
- 11 pupils aged between 11-17 on foot
- 7 pupils aged between 7-11 on foot
- 0 unaccompanied pupils

Due to the low numbers of pedestrians, neither a school crossing warden nor a zebra crossing would be viable.

# **Parking**

For safety reasons the car park is for the use of staff and visitors to the school only. Parents using the car park to drop off children at the start and end of the school day are causing obstructions in the car park which is dangerous for the children and pedestrians alike. We



respectfully ask that parents do not use the car park to drop or collect their children so that we can all, as a school community, ensure the safety of all the children on site.
