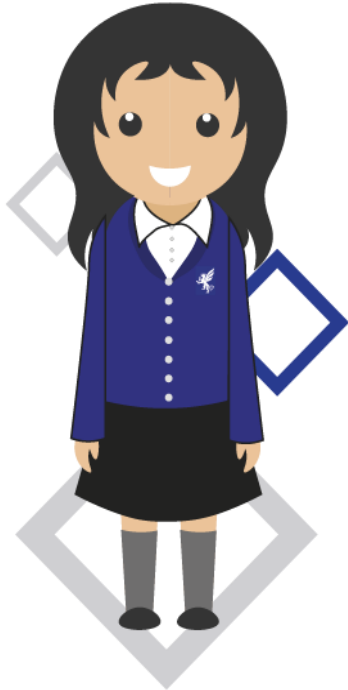

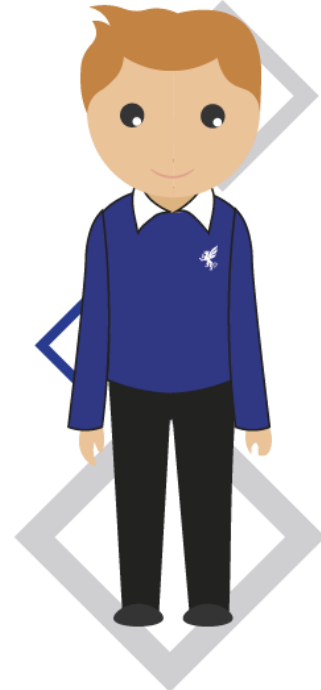
Uniform
