Dear parents/carers

You will be aware from our letter to you before half term that we have made some changes to how we use the school site. I am pleased to report that these changes have already had a very positive effect on student behaviour and punctuality to lessons. Many of you will be aware that we now have fewer secondary students on site than we historically used to have, and so the Elgar, Keynes and Morris buildings are adequate for the number of students we have, however we have acknowledged that at some points in the school day some corridors are quite busy and we have already taken steps to address this.

We would like to remind parents that all students need to be on site and in their form room by 8.40 each morning, and must enter by the bottom gate.

We would also like to ask parents who choose to collect their children by car to do so considerately, ensuring that parking restrictions are adhered to when parking in the local area and taking care not to block the driveways of local residents.

We would like to encourage safe and considerate parking and we will seek legal enforcement for any parent who puts our children at risk. Please be advised that the police may prosecute the owners of vehicles illegally parked on receipt of photographic evidence. Parents, residents and staff may take photographic evidence (front and rear of vehicle) and email this to Bournville@west-midlands.pnn.police.uk along with a written statement.

I would like to take this opportunity to personally thank the vast majority parents who do commit to helping to keep our children safe on their journeys to and from school.
