

Covid-19 Catch Up Funding 2020/21

Following the disruption of school closures due to the global pandemic, the government have awarded two catch up grants for schools to use to support students in catching up on their learning. The 11-16 grant allocated at a fixed cost of £80 per child. Schools are free to spend the Covid grant as they see fit. However, they are accountable for how they have used the additional funding to support students affected by Covid-19.

Funding available: £46,000

Objectives:

• To raise the aspirations, attainment and improve the progress and life outcomes of those

students affected by school closures in March 2020.

• To support students in learning, knowing and remembering more to enable them to access the

curriculum, following school related closures.

• To ensure that students sitting examinations in June 2021 are not negatively impacted by Covid related school closures through either lost curriculum time or poor attendance on return.
