



# Bournville School Curriculum Overview



## Curriculum Intent Statement: Health and Social Care

The BTEC Tech Award is a practical introduction to life and work in Health and Social Care, allowing students to develop their understanding of the sector and to see whether it's an industry they'd like to have a career in.

The course is assessed primarily through practical tasks where students apply their knowledge to work-related contexts. Components are sequenced in order as they build on each other allowing students to develop in confidence. Firstly students 'explore', then 'develop', lastly 'apply' their knowledge to real life scenarios. Interleaving supports students in applying knowledge in different contexts. Component three is a synoptic unit, assessed by examination drawing together knowledge from the entire course.

More than the specification is taught to students, giving a depth of learning that will engage students and prepare them for study and employment beyond GCSE level. Students will be given opportunities to work with health care professionals and to discover first-hand the way real health care services operate. The Award will help students to develop knowledge and understanding through applying their learning and allow them to gain the skills need for further study and employment.
