

## Bournville School Curriculum Intent Statement 21-22

## History

At Bournville, our intended aims are fulfilled by providing a broad, balanced curriculum offer that also helps pupils make sense of the past. Historical periods have been mapped out so that the youngest pupils identify their own family history before looking at the history of the local area and then national history. In lower key stage 2 pupils develop their chronological understanding by learning about different stages in British history with upper key stage 2 applying their chronological understanding to identify historical concepts throughout British history and significant aspects of the history of the wider world. The curriculum offer is carefully mapped out to ensure that prior conceptual knowledge and skills are recalled, recapped, reviewed and built upon. The offer also ensures that pupils from our diverse catchment can see themselves and their family in British and world history.

The aims for teaching History in our school are:

- To develop a sense of place and understanding of the rich history of their family, the immediate locality and how it has changed over time
- To develop pupil's ability to compare and contrast about how and why the world, our country and culture have developed over time
- To develop a context for their growing sense of identity
- To develop a secure understanding of sequence and chronology
- To enhance knowledge of significant events and people and why significant changes happened
- To ensure pupils understand historical bias and how this had an impact on events at the time and part of our culture
- To inspire pupils' curiosity to know more about the past
- To fulfil the requirements of the National Curriculum for history
