Dear Parent/Carer,


We are continuing to raise standards in school. Our recent Ofsted inspection report stated that our school is improving in all areas, but one of the things we need to continue to work on is the punctuality of our students.

We have a line-up procedure in order to support students to be on time for the lessons after social times. The vast majority of students follow this procedure every day, however, some students do not do this and are therefore late to lessons. This has an impact on their lesson time, but can also disrupt the learning of others by entering the classrooms late.

In order to improve this, we will be making a change to our behaviour system from Monday 7<sup>th</sup> February. Students that do not attend the lineup after social time will have this logged as a consequence on class charts. This was previously a -1 negative behaviour, but will now be -4 and trigger a detention. This will not be an issue for those students who regularly meet the agreed school standard and will encourage those that are not following the procedure to improve their punctuality.

Thank you for your support with this as we continue to raise our standards for students at Bournville.
