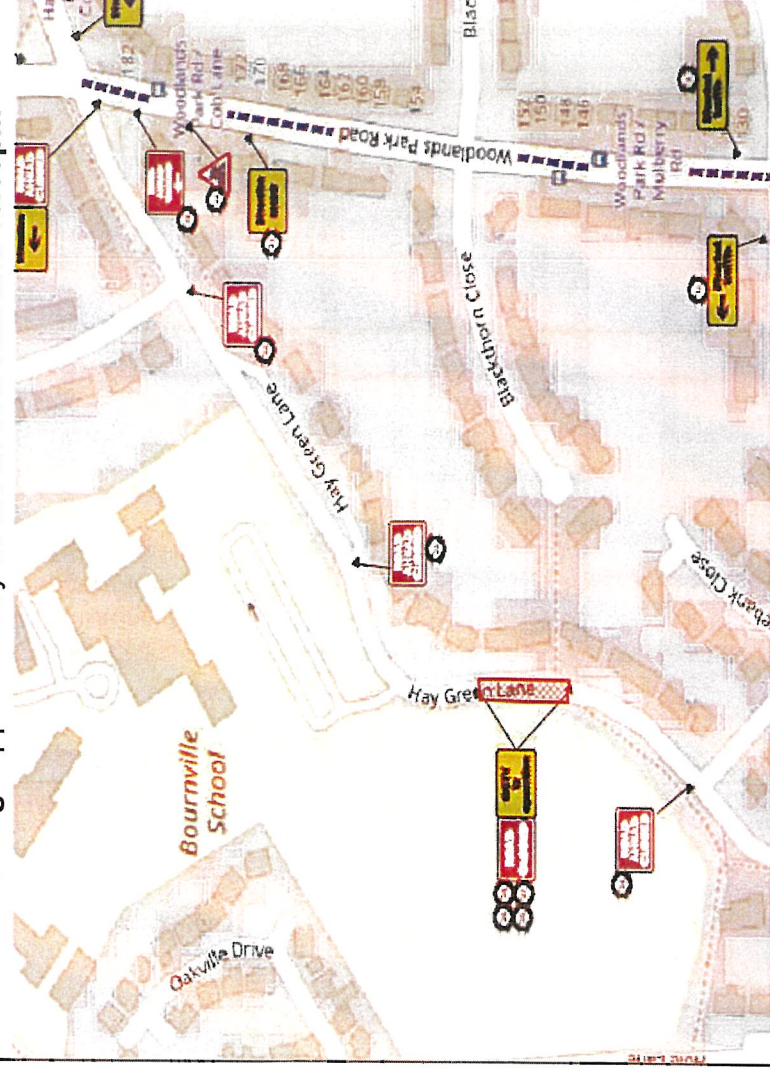

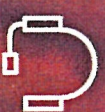
## Parking and Property Access
