Parent/Carer Advice Meetings

Speech & Language Therapy /Occupational Therapy

Who should attend the advice meeting?

Advice meetings should be attended by you and somebody from your child's childminder, nursery or school. This could be their key worker, teacher or school SENCo.

Should my child be there?

No. This is not a direct assessment of your child.

What will happen during the advice meeting?

You will have a chance to discuss your child's needs and any concerns you have. The Speech and Language Therapist or Occupational Therapist will listen to you and offer advice around developing your child's skills at home and at their childminders, nursery or school.

How long will the advice meeting last?

The advice meeting will last up to 30 minutes.

Where will the advice meeting be?

The advice meeting will be virtual.
