EYFS Outdoor Learning

Outdoor learning is a key experience for our EYFS Children in Bournville Primary. We believe in supporting the development of healthy and active life styles. Outdoor learning helps our children respect and experience nature. It gives them opportunities to problem solve, take risks in a safe environment, be creative and imaginative.



EYFS | What do we learn?

We aim to teach our children a meaningful, content-rich curriculum that will develop their cultural literacy and ensure excellent academic achievement.

Through carefully planned themes, well-chosen resources and trips, we will foster in our children an appreciation of our rich and varied literary heritage.

At the heart of our English curriculum are the elements needed for children to acquire a wide vocabulary and an understanding of grammar and knowledge of linguistic conventions for reading, writing and the spoken language.





EYFS | What do we learn?

We want our children to develop a love for and an enjoyment of the wonders of the mathematical world, which will involve spotting patterns, making connections, and finding new ways of looking at things. We aim for pupils to become creative mathematicians who can confidently play with ideas, draw pictures, have the courage to experiment and ask good questions.

Through building up a body of key foundational knowledge and concepts, our pupils are encouraged to recognise the power of rational explanation and develop a sense of excitement and curiosity about natural phenomena. They are encouraged to understand how science can be used to explain what is occurring, predict how things will behave, and analyse causes.

It is important that children become well rounded learners with an interest in Humanities, the Arts, Languages and Sport. We ensure that they are provided with a

rich wider curriculum throughout their school day and have further opportunities at lunchtime and after school.

Reading

A love of books and reading is essential to Bournville. As part of their daily provision, all our children have a reading lesson and enjoy story time at the end of the day. They have independent opportunities throughout the school day to read and explore books. This could be through the reading corner in the classroom, visiting our library at lunchtime or attending 'Bournville Bookworms Club'. We work in partnership with parents to equip you with the skills to support your child on their reading journey.

Outdoor Learning

We recognise that although qualifications are very important, school is much more than examinations. Our students benefit from a range of creative, sporting and cultural activities. Additional opportunities outside of the classroom are wide ranging. The PE department offer a number of clubs from football, table tennis, basketball and netball. Everybody is welcome whether you are an expert or a beginner.

We have ample opportunities throughout the year for students to participate in school performances, both musical, drama and talent.

More details of everything that is on offer can be found on our website. Most clubs and activities are after school.

At Bournville homework is an integral part of the learning experience. We set high standards and expect all homework to be completed to the best of a student's ability and to be handed in on time. Students can access Purple Mash, Spelling Shed and Maths Shed from home at any time so that learning can continue outside the classroom.

We believe travel is an important component of every child's development, giving a chance to be away from home and to allow a greater sense of independence. From the residential trip in Year 7 to major expeditions for the older students there are opportunities for students to enrich their learning and widen their horizons.

Extra Curricular

We are proud of the Extra Curricular activities we are able to offer our children in every Key Stage. An extensive array of opportunities within the school day and after school are available. Our activities range from sporting clubs to music opportunities, to our Eco Group and many more. As an all-through school, specialist facilities are used for these activities.

Every term all children have the opportunity to experience either a curriculum linked trip or visitors to the school, which will enrich understanding of what they are learning.

We want the children to be given the opportunity to enjoy and embrace all areas of learning as they grow and move through the school.

Wellbeing

Well-being is at the heart of Bournville School Primary. For children to flourish, it is important they are happy and secure in themselves. In order to fulfil this, we have trained Mental Health First Aiders, regular Nurture Groups and equip our children with skills such as relaxation techniques and practicing yoga in order to work on their mental well-being.





What does the future hold?

Pupils gain from being able to participate in specially planned projects with the Secondary pupils and staff.

As your child goes into Upper Key Stage Two, we are able to begin the transition process to the Secondary Provision. This enables children to further familiarise themselves with the Secondary environment and teachers, significantly reducing the anxiety often associated with the move to Secondary education.

Safeguarding and Child Protection


