Dear Parent/Carer

RE: 'Blackwell Court – Multi Activity Adventure Day'– Thursday 8th September 2022.

We have been fortunate enough to have been able to book all of year 11 (current year 10) on a team building day at Blackwell Adventure in Bromsgrove.

The day will consist of a series of adventure activities such as laser tag; tree climb; zip wire; high ropes course; abseiling and an outdoor climb. Groups will rotate around five different activities.

We will leave school by coach at 9.00am and be back around 4.00pm. We have subsidised this trip so there is no cost to students. Due to the nature of the trip students will be required to wear comfortable clothes or their PE kit. In addition, they may need a coat or additional jumper and / or jogging bottoms. Depending on the weather, sun cream may also be required. A briefing explaining this to all student will take place before the end of summer term.

We will be travelling by coach. If your child is entitled to a free school meal, they will be able to collect a packed lunch from the canteen before we leave. Please identify on the consent form if your child requires a packed lunch. If your child is not entitled to a free school meal, they must bring a **packed lunch** with them. In addition, it is advisable to bring sufficient drinks for the day. Please note, students will not be permitted to eat on the coach.

Staff in charge of the party will take all reasonable care of the students, they cannot necessarily be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury suffered to students arising during, or out of, the school visit. **By returning the consent form for this trip you are agreeing to give permission for the staff in charge to act in loco parentis if medical treatment is required. Without the consent letter returned, your child will not be able to attend this event.**

If your child has any medical and/or dietary requirements please ensure this is detailed on the consent form. Any child that requires medication, e.g. asthma inhaler / epipen, it is essential that they bring these on the day.
