Dear Parent/carer,

RE: Aston Villa Trip

Your child has been selected to go to Villa Park on Tuesday 14th November 2023. We will leave school at 8.30am and returning at the latest 3.15pm dependant on traffic. This is a great opportunity for your child to represent Bournville School at Villa Park and experience 2 different components of the iconic football ground.

First component – They will have a tour around the iconic Villa Park, learning about the history of Aston Villa and Villa Park.

Second component – They will be coached by a FA/UEFA qualified coach at the New Aston Villa Inner City Academy ground (moulded boots are required). Your child will be coached and play for 2 hours, please ensure they bring plenty of fluids for the duration of this activity.

Please be aware that there are a limited number of spaces on this trip and your child has been selected for their efforts in P.E, attendance at clubs and their excellence in P.E. If your child is entitled to a free school meal, they can collect a packed lunch from the canteen, however, please ensure they have their own fluids. If they are not entitled to a free school meal, please provide them with a packed lunch and including drinks. All children must wear P.E kit on the day of the trip.

If any of your child's medical details have changed and you have not yet notified the school, please contact Mrs Jones to request a new medical consent form. Please ensure your child has their medication needed to attend, otherwise your child will not be able to attend.

Payment:

If you wish your child to take part in this visit, payment can be made by debit or credit card online via Parent Pay the cost for this trip is £20.00. Unfortunately, we can no longer accept cash or cheques in school. Payment for this trip will close on Monday 6th November 2023.

To pay for the trip, log in to your child's Parent Pay account. The trip name will appear in 'Pay for other items'. Then click 'View details and pay'. When you have added the trip to your basket, click 'Pay now'. You will then be able to pay securely by credit or debit card.

Please note that by making payment via Parent Pay you are providing consent for your child to attend the trip. Staff in charge of the party will take all reasonable care of the students, they cannot necessarily be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury suffered to students arising during, or out of, the school visit. **By paying for this trip you are agreeing to give permission for the staff in charge to act in loco parentis if medical treatment is required.**

Refunds:

Any request for refunds will be subject to an overall review of affordability of this trip by the academy. This is because some trips require the school to pay non-refundable deposits for items such as tickets, accommodation or coaches prior to the trip. If your child is unable to attend the trip at very short notice then please be assured we will always do our best to find a student who can take their place, thus enabling us to afford refunds, but if we are unable to do this then we may be unable to offer refunds.

Places on the visits are subject to the exemplary behaviour of your child as an ambassador of Bournville. Any breach in behaviour prior to the visits may result in your child being removed from the visit.
