**RE: Y11 Revision sessions during the half term break.**

At Bournville school we are dedicated to our student's bright futures 100%, 100% of the time. Which is why we have now introduced revision sessions during the half term break to help boost attainment and progress. During these sessions we aim to improve all our students academically, regardless of their starting points and current attainment. Daily registers for both the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> of November will be taken, so we can keep track of attendance and to also celebrate the students making excellent decisions for their futures.
