

Bournville Deaf Resource Base is situated in a Mainstream Secondary School for students aged 11 to 16 and is in the south of the city. All of the students who come to the Deaf Resource Base have an Education Health and Care Plan (EHCP) for hearing loss, ranging from moderate to profound.

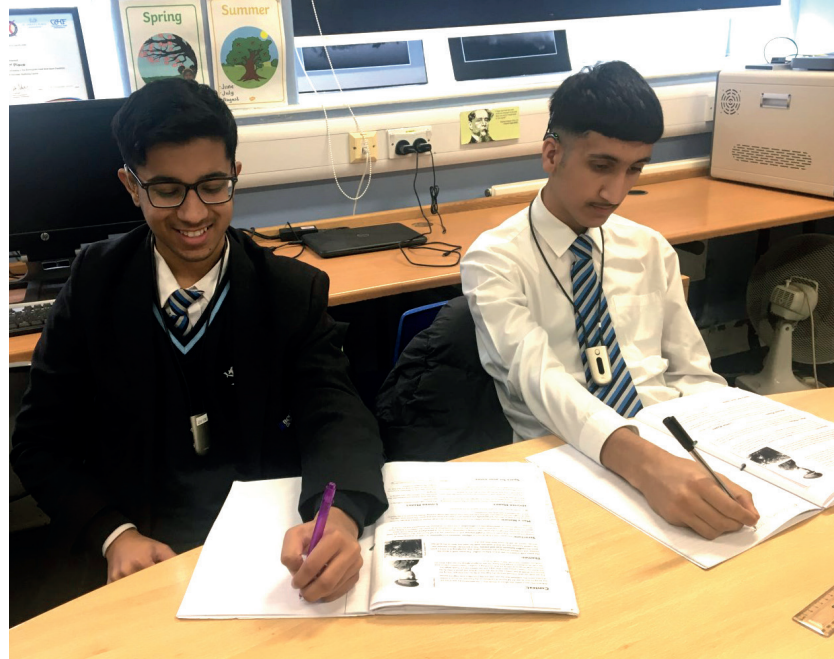
### Specialist Staff

Students have support from a Teacher of the Deaf and a specialist Hearing Impaired Teaching Assistant. Teaching is tailored to meet individual needs but may include;

- In class support,
- Individual or small group pre and post tutoring,
- Individual or small group Speech and Language intervention,
- Management of Access Arrangements for exams,
- Regular visits from an Educational Audiologist.

We adopt a "Total Communication" philosophy, which means that we use a range of communication methods, including English and British Sign Language,

Signed Supported English and Signed English to ensure the best access to the curriculum.
