School will commence as normal at 8:30am and end after period 3. Students will go to their period 4 lesson and by 12:30pm they will be dismissed from school.


We understand the importance of family traditions and the joy that the holiday season brings. We hope that this adjustment will allow you and your family to make the most of this special time together.
