The Key Stage 2 SATs will take place from Monday 12th May to Thursday 15th May 2025. It is essential that all Year 6 pupils attend school promptly each day.

Monday 12th May	English Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (Paper 1 & 2)
Tuesday 13th May	English Reading
Wednesday 14th May	Maths Paper 1 (Arithmetic) & Maths Paper 2 (Reasoning)
Thursday 15th May	Maths Paper 3 (Reasoning)

SATs will be sat in the morning, so it is important children arrive on time

## SATs Week Breakfast:

To help ensure children are settled and ready to begin each day positively, we are offering a free breakfast for all Year 6 pupils during SATs week. This will be served from 8:00am. Children are encouraged to attend, as this provides a calm and supportive environment before the tests begin. Breakfast will include a selection of cereals, toast, fruit, and juice. Staff will be on hand to offer support and encouragement, and this also gives children a chance to chat with friends and ease any nerves.
