### **Welcome to year 3 and 4**

Welcome back to another exciting school year! It's a pleasure to have your children back in my classroom for Year 3 and 4. As we embark on this new academic journey together, I am filled with enthusiasm and anticipation for the wonderful experiences and growth that lie ahead.

I have enclosed a copy of our Curriculum Overview for this half term. It is packed with lots of exciting and diverse opportunities for your child to learn about and share their ideas and experiences with us.

On Monday, spellings and times tables will be provided to students. This is compulsory and must be completed and handed in by Friday (it can be handed in any day of the week). Pupils are also expected to read 3 times a week with an adult, or an older sibling and their homework book signed. Children will be able to receive awards at school for reading at home. On top of this, there will be an optional homework grid with activities for the children to complete.

This DOES NOT have to be completed, this is for parents/children who would like extra homework. If children would like to bring in their own notepads to use for homework, they can bring them in to school so we can prepare for our Monday launch. An A4 size would be best. We do not want homework to be a big battle for parents at home, therefore if homework is not handed in by Friday, we will keep your children in at lunchtime to complete the work with a teacher.

### School photos

On Wednesday 17th September we have our school photos. All children **MUST** be in their school uniform for the photos. A reminder, if children have siblings in secondary and would like a picture, they must arrive at the school at 8am where a teacher will greet them and take them too secondary.

We are lucky enough to get Miss McCauley as our teaching assistant this year. She will be helping around the classroom ensuring children get the best support possible, as well as setting up intervention groups for those children that need the extra support.
